- WatchDOGS are fathers, grandfathers, uncles, and other father-figures.
- WatchDOGS may read and work on flash cards with students, play at recess, eat lunch with students, watch the school entrances and hallways, assist with traffic flow and any other assigned activities where they actively engage with not only their own students, but other students as well.

- Students gain a positive male role model.
- Schools gain an extra set of eyes and ears.
- The presence of a father or father-figure enhances a sense of security at the building.
- Fathers get a glimpse of their students' everyday world.
- Fathers gain a greater awareness of the positive impact they can have on their student's life.
